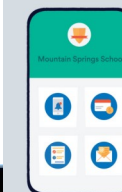

Last Thursday and Friday I attended the Leaders Day and Literacy Summit at the Adelaide Convention Centre. It was a great opportunity to attend some fantastic workshops and learn more about the latest research-based methodologies in education. I was one of the leaders asked to present a masterclass session, and I presented about our own 'Literacy Loops' that we developed here in 2016. It was a bit daunting presenting to 80 Principals and Leaders, however exciting at the same time to share the fantastic work that we do. Other presentations I attended included how to extend oral language in the Junior Primary Years, and challenging students in Mathematics. I am very excited to share this learning with staff and further strengthen our teaching and thus student learning. Next week we are expecting the installation of our exciting new cubby house, which was kindly funded by the Variety Club of South Australia.
