


## Student Safety

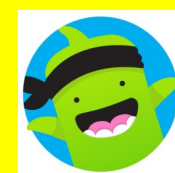

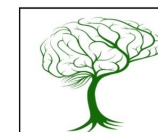
